1.0 BACKGROUND

2.0 The qualifications and duties for each of the positions above are described below:

A. LECTURER

Requirement: A Lecturer must have: i) a Bachelor of Surgery and Bachelor of Medicine (MBBS) or MD and possession of PhD or Master of Medicine degree in the relevant field ii) completed a one year internship from a recognized tertiary hospital iii) show evidence of engagement in research iv) University Teaching Experience will be considered an added advantage.

For candidates to be considered for appointment they will be required to apply for full registration with the Tanzania Medical Council.

Duties: The successful candidates will teach and supervise undergraduate students, conduct research and undertake consultancy projects and provide clinical care in affiliated hospitals. Consideration for appointment will take into account relevant qualifications, teaching, clinical and research experience.

B. ASSISTANT LECTURER

Requirement: Possession of a good Master's Degree (B+ or above GPA 3.8 - 3.6) in a relevant discipline or equivalent after having attained a GPA of 3.8 and above at

undergraduate level. He/she must be computer literate, being capable of using ICT to enhance teaching and learning.

Duties: The successful candidates will teach in face to face sessions and lead seminars to undergraduate students, set and mark course assignments and/or tests and examinations, supervise field work, practical and all other related academic activities, conduct research work and disseminate research findings, and undertake consultancy projects.

Remuneration: The University offers a competitive salary and benefits commensurate with experience and qualifications.
